4pm – 9pm. We invite you to come and meet the artist and join us for drinks, a bite to eat and a glass of wine.


"By re-working 1950's imagery and interweaving thought-provoking captions, I create art that is nostalgic, visually arresting and instantly relatable.

The Works

As Mr Controversial is deepening his creative process, he has been experimenting with full oil paintings and hand pulled diamond dust silkscreens. He has fallen in love with the printmaking process, each hand made print is truly unique due to the nature of such a manual process. A subtle thing like not applying too much pressure in one spot when pushing the ink through the screen will create a totally different effect. This is then emphasised by the hand finishing which is different for each image in the series. He is excited as he has never released something like this before.



Artist Biography

He is controversial in the way he has just recently come onto the art scene and has already had an impact and captured the eyes of established collectors and an audience. He argues his 'lack of' traditional art training allows him to create outside of traditional form and convention; "I envision the piece I want to create and pull together the various elements in order to create it, I don't allow my limitations to prevent me from creating. I believe true creativity is working outside your limits." A fresh approach to fine art.

Unlike a lot of his art world peers, he doesn't take himself too seriously and is not desperate to be liked. He wants to create art that is authentic to him, if he has something to say, he's going to say it! Therefore, his approach and the way he communicates is dark, satirical, fearless, and controversial but it's his truth. Many of Mr Controversial's followers, fans and collectors respect and appreciate his honesty and authenticity, in fact they often feel they can relate to it

Artists Background

Drawing from his professional experience in the advertising industry working on campaigns for a variety of brands, his work is born out of a passion for crafting engaging visual communication

and marketing psychology; understanding the science behind the things we buy, buy into and /or share and also personal frustrations of a social media obsessed world.

Mr Controversial is a student of history, from Ancient Rome to WW2 and the Civil Rights movement and he loves the classic, timeless look of vintage imagery.

"I want to honour and respect it whilst making it relevant for today's generation of digital addicts – regardless of age, gender, race, sexual orientation. Ironically, I take images rooted in old world views of misogyny, racism, prejudice created during a turbulent time in history to create art that unites. No matter who you are, if you can relate to this piece, it's for you."
